

Great Dalby Pupil Premium Information 2017/18



Great Dalby will receive **£8140** to support those children who are entitled to Free School Meals or are on the 'Ever 6' register. Each pupil will receive £1320 each which will be used to support their learning and wider school experiences. At Great Dalby we have 2 children entitled to FSM (1.4%) and 5 children on the E6 list (3.5%). Please see the strategies employed and the expected impact. This will be reviewed in July 2018.
