

Pupil Premium Funding 2015/16

The pupil premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

At Great Dalby 1.4% (2) of our pupils are in receipt of pupil premium funding and we have been allocated £2640 in pupil premium funding for the academic year 2015/16.

One of our pupils is in Year 1, the other in Year 3.

Neither of our pupil premium children is working below the levels of their peers or below the levels expected of their chronological ages, in fact in some areas both children are working at levels above their peers. Support or intervention outside of the classroom would add no value to their academic learning. Both children are quiet and do not easily engage with their peers in group situations. Pupil premium funding for 2015/16 has contributed towards the cost of adult provision in the relevant classrooms to facilitate and encourage positive and constructive group interaction and thereby develop the children's confidence in group situations.
