

Great Dalby Primary School Addendum to Behaviour Policy due to Coronavirus Pandemic

When the children return to school, following the school closure on the 20th March 2020, things will look and feel very different in school. The following changes to expectations in school will be shared with the parents and children prior to their return. The children will also be reminded of these new expectations by their teacher in school. All other elements of the Great Dalby Behaviour Policy remain and we expect you to follow our Golden Standards at all times.

- Wash your hands before leaving your house and travelling to school.



- Bring only a water bottle, lunch-box, a coat and sun-hat to school. Apply sun cream before coming to school if you need it.

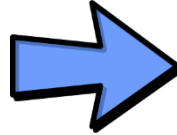


- Use hand sanitiser on your hands on your way into school.

- Come into school through your group's entrance.

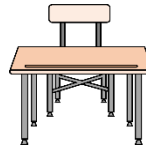


- Follow the arrows when you are moving around school.



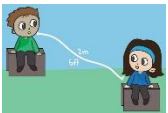
- Use only the toilets for your group.

- In the classroom, sit at the table with your name on.



- If you sneeze or cough, catch it in your elbow or use a tissue. If using a tissue, bin it after.

- At play-times, play only in the area which you asked to play in.



- Try to keep 2 meters away from other people.

- Try not to touch anybody else in school.



- Wash your hands with soap, for 20 seconds, after going to the toilet.

- Wash your hands with soap, for 20 seconds, before and after you eat.
