 une orange – an orange



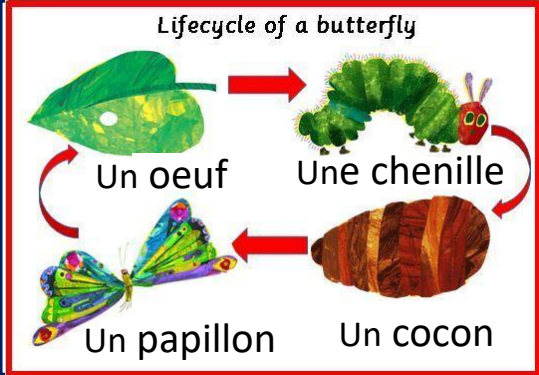
Les jours de la semaine - days of the week
 lundi - Monday
 mardi - Tuesday
 mercredi - Wednesday
 jeudi - Thursday
 vendredi - Friday
 samedi - Saturday
 dimanche - Sunday

Être – the verb ‘to be’
 The word for ‘is’ in French is **est** and the word for ‘are’ is **sont**.

La pomme **est** rouge – the apple is red. 

Les pommes **sont** rouges – the apples are red. 

The adjective ‘red’ also needs an ‘s’ for the plural.



Days of the week and months of the year do not have capital letters in French like they do in English (unless they are at the beginning of a sentence!).
